For different reasons, there are many grandparents who are raising their grandchildren. I am one of the many who is raising their grandchild. We never thought that we would be raising another child at our ages. We were asked by many people if we were sure that we wanted to do this. There was no question about it for us. We gladly took on the responsibility without any reservations.

We received legal guardianship of our grandson Alex when he was 5 years old. He will soon be turning 13. It has not been easy but has been an interesting and rewarding journey.

I have been told that it is not like it use to be years ago when your grandparents were just as good as your parents could act on your behalf. They could enroll you in school and even take you to the doctor. Today it is not like that. If you do not have a legal paper giving you legal authority, you will not be able to do anything for that child and that is so sad. Some of the children are just dropped off the left with their grandparents for long periods of time and the grandparents do not have any authority over the child. This all has to be handled through the legal system and can be a long process.

It is amazing how the things that used to bother us when our children were young don't seem to be a problem now. I know it has not been easy for Alex either. Sometimes he looks at us like we are from another planet. I know that we are set in our ways on some things but we are definitely more relaxed, understanding and open minded. I guess we've learned not to worry about the little things because we know that there are bigger things to come. One of the hardest things for me so far is homework!!!! We spend many hours trying to understand the dynamics of it all. It is still a work in progress.

The emotional, financial and physical aspects of it all can be challenging. We try not to think too far ahead and just go day by day and deal with whatever is thrown our way. Although this was not part of are long range plan we are moving forward no matter where this journey takes us we would not have any other way.
